Burton Green Bonus - Booking and Payment

We continue to have ever increasing demands for Before and After School Activities. This means that places for all clubs need to be booked in advance and school notified if your child is not attending a club when they are expected. Should you need to collect your child from a club earlier than the normal finish time please let Mrs Thompson know beforehand so arrangements can be made.

Booking forms are always sent out a few weeks before the end of term to allow plenty of time for booking. If you know that you need an activity on a particular evening it is essential that you book a place immediately by sending the completed form back to Mrs Thompson via the school office. We cannot guarantee places if you do not do this as we arrange staffing to certain adult-child ratios dependent on activities.
