What a fantastic way to end the half term with Science Week inspiring many budding scientists of the future. All categories of science from biology, chemistry and physics have been covered. Have a fabulous and safe half term break and we look forward to seeing you all return on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> June.

### Class Highlights of the Week:

#### Maple Class:

Wow! What an exciting week we've had! The children in Maple class have helped write about what we've been doing... On Monday our first experiment involved finding out why spiders don't get stuck on their own web. We carried out a coloured celery investigation and have been busy scientists creating lots of fun!

#### Cedar Class:

We have been enjoying learning about changes that occur with acids and bases. We have written experiment instructions and conclusions too.

#### Damson & Oak Class:

Damson and Oak classes have joined together this week. We have been enjoying science week. We started as biologists dissecting flowers and collecting data. Then we became chemists looking at chemical reactions. Finally, we became physicists looking at air resistance!
