End of Key Stage Assessment Results

As we come to the end of term we would like to celebrate the achievements of children in both Year 2 and Year 6.

Each child should feel very proud of what they have achieved. This is the result of their considerable

hard work and their high expectations of what they can achieve. The cohort in Key Stage 1 is 15 and in Key Stage 2 it is 17.

The expectations of the standard at the end of Key Stages 1 and 2 continue to rise year on year.

Year 1 Phonics

73% of our children are working at the expected standard.

Key Stage 1

Reading: Working at the expected standard 93% of whom 27% were working at greater depth.

Writing: Working at the expected standard 73% of whom 13% were working at greater depth.

Mathematics: Working at the expected standard 87% of whom 27% were working at greater depth.

Reading, Writing and Mathematics: Working at the expected standard in all 3 areas school result 67%, of whom 13% were working at greater depth.

Key Stage 2

Reading: School result: Working at the expected standard 100% of whom 76% were working at greater depth.

Writing: School result: Working at the expected standard 94% of whom 29% were working at greater depth.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling School result: Working at the expected standard 100% of whom 88% were working at greater depth.

Mathematics School result: Working at the expected standard 100% of whom 76% were working at greater depth.

Reading, Writing and Mathematics: Working at the expected standard in all 3 areas school result 94%, of whom 24% were working at greater depth.

Please note that it is only in writing that we are allowed to award working at greater depth for teacher assessment.

I would like to thank children and parents for their efforts. Congratulations to you all. High achievement is not possible without a dedicated staff throughout the school and staff who are always willing to go that extra mile!
